BabyNet services for Healthy Connections members

Effective October 1, 2019, Healthy Blue will assume educational review and payment responsibility for BabyNet services for Healthy Connections members. According to South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS), BabyNet is the state's early intervention system for infants and toddlers under 3 years of age with developmental delays or conditions associated with developmental delays.

Providers that are enrolled to service members in the SCDHHS BabyNet program may continue to render these services, but will still need to call Healthy Blue to create the case and build the authorization.

Providers can do this by submitting two forms to Healthy Blue:

1. The *Universal BabyNet Prior Authorization Form*, found here:

2. The *Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) Form*. Access to the *IFSP Form* is granted to providers through enrollment into the BabyNet program offered by SCDHHS.

Healthy Blue will honor the IFSP in place prior to October 1, 2019, through the coordination of care period (ending on December 31, 2019).

To continue to render BabyNet services after December 31, 2019, you must enroll as a provider with Healthy Blue.
