

## Guide to accessing and using online formularies

Healthy Blue formularies are available by following the simple steps below.

### For providers

- Visit [www.HealthyBlueSC.com](http://www.HealthyBlueSC.com) and select **Providers**.
- Go to the *Pharmacy* page and select **Drug Lists**. Select **Searchable Formulary**.

### For members

- Visit [www.HealthyBlueSC.com](http://www.HealthyBlueSC.com) and select **Members**.
- Go to the *Pharmacy* page and select **Searchable Formulary**. This will open the *Healthy Blue Formulary*.

### Searching the formulary

There are three ways to start a search:

1. You can search alphabetically from the *Alphabetical Search* list.
2. You can enter a drug name in the *Brand & Generic Name Search* field.
3. You can choose a therapeutic class as a starting point from the *Therapeutic Class Search* list.

Please select a drug from the list below to see all coverage details regarding the medication. Some medications listed may have additional requirements or limitations of coverage. These requirements and limits may include prior authorization, quantity limits, age limits or step therapy.

Medications not listed on the formulary are considered to be non-formulary and are subject to prior authorization.

- Restrictions including quantity limits, dose optimizations, prior authorizations and step therapies
- Special notes for the prescriber




#### Definition of Restrictions

Icon	Restriction	Definition
	Age Limit Restriction	Coverage of this drug may be based on member age.
	Clinical Criteria	Click on the link for additional coverage details.
	Dose Optimization	Normally involves the conversion from twice-daily dosing to a once-daily dosing schedule.
	Female Only	Coverage is limited to females only.
	Generic Indicator	Generics are simply copies of brand-name drugs. Brand-name and generic drugs have the same active ingredients, strength and dose. And the FDA requires that generic drugs meet the same high safety standards for purity, quality, safety and strength.
	Male Only	Coverage is limited to males only.
